Accessing the Power of the Vestibular-Auditory-Visual Triad

Code: CA-12A-05

The vestibular, auditory, and visual systems are key for organizing sensory input. Together these key systems provide us with our sense of self in time and space.

This course will examine the neurodevelopmental aspects of the vestibular/proprioceptive systems and their resultant links with the visual and auditory systems. A wide range of practical intervention strategies will be revealed through hands-on movement labs and discussion of video samples.

Upon completion, you will be able to:

- Discuss the development of the vestibular-auditory-visual (V-A-V) triad and each systems role in development of spatial temporal orientation.
- Be able to recognize vestibular proprioceptive processing difficulties and their contribution to postural development, vision, and audition.
- Have the tools to create simple yet powerful strategies to activate the power of the V-A-V triad across multiple environments.
